| 2 | Haifa | nil | This woman is another former “white slave” rescued by a ministry in Haifa . She married her husband some months ago and she is pregnant while inflicted with hepatitis C. Her husband very recently found a job after many months of unemployment and will receive his first salary in September. In the meantime, they literally have no income and are living on borrowed money and whatever other help they can find. | \$560 |
| 6 | Karmiel | \$1338 | The mother of four young children is working while the husband remains at home. Her mother will soon arrive from the Ukraine and will take over child care while he hopefully is able to find work. In the meantime, they are unable to pay for return to school expenses for their children and barely are able to put food on the table. | \$560 |
| 7 | Karmiel | \$2088 | This large family with five stair stepped children just moved from Haifa to Karmiel. He was able to retain his job, but she was not and is looking for new employment. In the meantime, they are struggling to pay for the high cost of relocation and to keep up with normal living expenses. This gift will help them make the transition to their new situation. | \$500 |
| 1 | Or-Akiva | \$841 | This 70 year old widow/pensioner has stage three cancer and is undergoing chemo-therapy. On her small pension she is unable to bear the costs of frequent transportation to the hospital for this treatment, nor the cost of four medications which are not provided by her government insurance. This gift will cover these needs. | \$735 |

| 3 | Haifa | \$981 | The 58 year old husband was terminated from his job so that his employer would not have to pay him a pension. This is a common practice in Israel. His wife is working part time but is in ill health and is unable to extend her hours. As he continues to look for any kind of work they are falling into debt and are struggling to survive. This gift is for food and utilities. | \$529 |
| 4 | Beer Sheva | \$1340 | This woman with three young children is in the final stages of divorce. They are currently living with her parents but are unable to afford return to school expenses and clothing for the children. Her husband continues to supplement her very small salary but they are struggling to make the difficult transition to their new situation. | \$295 |
| 2 | Kiriat Bialik | \$1200 | The wife of this pensioner couple has serious dental problems that have long been neglected. They have no means of paying for this care from their small stipend. This gift will cover her most immediate needs at our associated clinic in Haifa. | \$500 |
| 6 | Afula | \$1216 | The head of this marginally surviving family desperately needs full mouth dentures that will be provided at a fraction of what they would normally cost by our associated clinic in Tiberias. Even though both parents are employed their combined income is woefully insufficient to include dental care. | \$795 |
| 3 | Haifa | \$975 | This pensioner couple has an adult son who is 100% handicapped living with them. The head of the family is in urgent need of dental care and is in constant pain. This gift will cover treatment at our associated clinic in Haifa that will resolve his most immediate problems. | \$500 |
