In the interim they are struggling to survive on a small government stipend and have fallen behind in their rent, utilities and other basics.	\$571
1	Jerusalem	\$712	This 78 year old widow has been washing her clothes by hand since her washing machine is no longer repairable. This gift is for the purchase of a new machine.	\$698
3	Kiriat Gat	\$1477	The head of this family started a business that failed recently and he has just gotten a job that will help them to recover and survive. In the interim they have fallen far behind in rent, utilities and other essentials. This gift is a bridge to help them get back to a stable situation.	\$444
3	Tel Aviv	\$1070	This 48 year old widow with two young children is undergoing chemo therapy following cancer surgery. Her husband was murdered by the Mafia for his non-payment of gambling debts, leaving his family alone and in a desperate financial situation. This gift is for help with rent and food.	\$819
3	Nesher	\$953	This divorced woman with a teenager must replace her entire solar water heating system since the main tank burst and caused extensive damage. She is struggling to survive since she has added medical expenses to treat her daughter for a chronic sickness that are not covered by her government insurance.	\$698
2	Kiriat Bialik	\$1319	This 67 year old pensioner is unable to pay for urgently needed dental care which leaves her in constant pain. She will be treated at our Haifa associated clinic.	\$540

1	Haifa	\$467	This young woman just escaped from several years as a “white slave” held as such by a gang in Tel Aviv. She is under treatment for Hepatitis C and will not be able to seek employment until her health is restored. She is unable to meet even her most basic needs on her small government stipend.	\$540
6	Arad	\$1810	The head of this large family went back to the States to earn sufficient money to care for their needs. While he was there his parents fell seriously ill and he became there unemployed care giver. He has just returned to Isreal and gotten a part time job. They have fallen far behind in rent, utilities and even food and are now living with friends until they can pay their most urgent debts and rent an apartment of their own.	\$540
2	Kiriat Bialik	\$1053	This couple in their 60’s are both disabled (he 100%, she 40%) Their 35 year old son reacted to an injection and has also become an invalid and is unable to work. Their collective government assistance is insufficient to meet all of their basic needs. This gift is for food.	\$317
2	Haifa	\$1230	This divorced mother of a teenager is unable to pay for their needs from her small stipend. She continues to seek employment. This gift is for food.	\$127
