The bottom line is that we are thrilled and so very thankful for your faithfulness and loving outreach that has brought us back nearly to the level we were at the beginning of the downturn.

I know that I know that I know that you will all be greatly blessed by what you are doing to bless Israel. God does not lie and His Word tells us so.

Thank you all from the bottom of my heart on behalf of all of our new immigrants that you have so generously benefited.

7	Nazaeth Illit	\$1,081	The mother of six ranging from ages 10 to 26 divorced her long term imprisoned husband and ran off to Russia to marry another man, leaving her two oldest daughters, ages 24 and 26 to manage the family in what was to be her short term absence. She has now ben gone for several months, both daughters who were employed have lost their jobs and the family is in dire financial condition and unable to make ends meet on the help they eceive via alimony and from the government. They are now on the brink of being evicted from their apartment and having their utilities terminated. This gift will prevent both of these happenings and provide food.	\$946
1	Mevaseret Zion	\$1,189	This 62 year old widow recently lost her job in Haifa and moved to a location near Jerusalem in order to be nearer to her adult daughter. She has applied for unemployment compensation but this will not be forthcoming for at least a number of weeks. To date she has been unable to find work in her new location. Consequently, she is unable to pay her rent and utilities and put food on her table. This gift will sustain her until hopefully she restores some source of income.	\$703
1	Nazareth Illit	\$728	This 58 year old divorced woman was surviving marginally on her part time salary and small government stipend until she was persuaded to share her apartment with another woman who had no financial resources and had no where else to go. This situation lasted for eight months until the free boarder finally found a job and went out on her own. In the meantime, however, her earlier provider fell on hard financial times while trying to support the two of them from her own meager resources. This gift will pay for a part of her in arrears rent.	\$378

1	Nazareth Illit	\$595	This 64 year old single woman is a 75% invalid who survives on a small government stipend. She is unable to afford even the “luxury” of dental care. The Olim Fund provided her with a set of lower dentures one year ago but due to insufficient resources at that time was unable to provide her with upper dentures as well. This gift will complete her dental care and she will at long last once again be able to eat normally.	\$541
2	Nazareth Illit	\$828	This 63 year old married pensioner is suffering from severe glaucoma that has already left her blind in one eye. Her other eye is enduring very high pressure but can be treated with a special pair of glasses that she has no resources to purchase, hence this urgently provided gift.	\$230
2	Maale Efraim	\$973	This 74 year old pensioner couple are both afflicted with severe dental problems which leave them in constant pain and distress. Their small stipend from the government is insufficient to pay for more than the most basic of their survival needs, much less any dental treatment. This gift will provide for their most urgently needed care.	\$1,027
1	Jerusalem	\$378	This 46 year old new immigrant is living in a woefully overcrowded, vermon infested apartment with 30 other women while she attends government provided language training. She is struggling to find a job so that she can escape from her unbearable circumstances. Recently, she found a small apartment. This gift will cover the first month’s rent with the hope and expectation that she will be able to support herself in the future.	\$541
2	Arad	\$1,191	This 49 year old divorced woman is 65% disabled and unable to work. She supports her 100% disabled 33 year old son who lives with her. She was in need of urgent dental care to relieve her constant pain, hence this gift.	\$459
4	Kiriat Bialik	\$1,850	This 44 year old woman is being treated for hepatitis C with expensive medications that are not provided by her insurance. Because of her illness she is only able to work part time and has applied for further assistance from the government. In the meantime the total family income is insufficient to pay for her urgently needed medications which will in the short term be provided by this gift.	\$568

5	Haifa	\$919	This 65 year old pensioner couple support the three children of their single parent daughter. Thus, their life style is extremely perilous. The electric company undercharged them for several months and then finally read their meter which led to what was for them an overwhelming catch up bill that they are unable to pay. This gift will take care of this one time emergency.	\$405
5	Tiberias	\$1,264	This 31 year old new widow lost her husband who died of dehydration during an outing in the desert. She is pregnant and has four children ages 12 to 2. Both she and her late husband were mentally impaired orphans and neither of them were able to work. She has fallen behind in her rent and utility payments while trying to sort out her financial future. This gift will help her bridge this requirement.	\$865
4	Hadera	nil	This 46 year old couple have two children living at home, ages 22 and 20, both are unemployed. The mother has now undergone two extensive surgeries for brain cancer and requires constant care at home which is provided by her husband who was forced to give up his job to care for his suffering wife. They have applied for urgent government assistance which has not yet been forthcoming, leaving them with no income and all of the basic needs for survival. This large gift will take care of their needs until, government support begins and/or the husband is able to return to work.	\$1,351
